Though number of grounds have been urged to assail the legality and validity of order dated 18.10.2016, considering that there exists a remedy of revision before the Tribunal and no specific ground of want of jurisdiction of the authority appears on record, I am not inclined to entertain this petition without insisting on exhaustion of alternative remedy. Therefore, the petition is dismissed with liberty to file revision before the competent authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has an apprehension that the appeal may not be decided expeditiously.
