1. This is the first bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the applicant who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.536/2016 registered at Police Station- Civil Lines, Raipur, District Raipur (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code.
2. As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that the applicant on the basis of a forged certificate of M.A. Final History subject, obtained job of Teacher in Panchayat. Subsequently, when it revealed the applicant resigned the job. Thereby, the offence has been committed.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the form was filled up through one Ghanshyam Yadav, therefore, false declaration was made and after knowing the fact, the

applicant himself has resigned the job on 04.04.2014. He further submits that the charge sheet has been filed and no further investigation is necessary, therefore, the applicant may be released on bail.

4. Per contra, learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of bail.
5. Perused the case diary and the documents. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that charge sheet has been filed and the evidence appears to be documentary in nature, I am inclined to release the applicant on bail.
6. Accordingly, the bail application filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is allowed.
7. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court, for his appearance as and when directed.
