(2) This is the second bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.50/2015 registered at Police Station Bilaigarh, District Baloda Bazar-Bhatapara, for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294, 427, 452, 506, 323, 307, 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

(3) The applicants' first bail application was dismissed on merits by order of this Court dated 31.07.2015 passed in M.Cr.C.
