1. Learned counsel for the applicants prays for final disposal of the instant MCRC.

After perusal of Annexure-A/1, order of the Second Additional Sessions Judge, Bilaspur, C.G. passed in bail petition No.229/2017 dated 02-03-2017, it appears that the trial is going on before the trial Court and a few witnesses were examined. However, learned counsel for the applicants is not in a position to state when the charges are framed and since when the trial is pending.
