(1) This criminal misc. petition is directed against the order dated 04.12.2014 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Mungeli in Criminal Revision No. 13/2009 by which the applicant's revision for enhancement of the amount of maintenance has been dismissed.

(2) Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the amount of maintenance, which had been enhanced from ₹ 1,700/- to ₹ 2,700/- is on the lower side, which deserves to be enhanced suitably.
