1. Heard on the application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. This is first bail application before this Court by the applicant for regular bail. The applicant was arrested on 11-10-2017 in connection with Crime No.44/2017 registered by Excise Circle Bilha, District Bilaspur, C.G. for the offence under Section 34(2) of the C.G. Excise Act.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. He is in custody since 11-10-2017. Hence, he may be enlarged on bail.
3. Learned counsel for the State/non-applicant opposes the application and submission. It is submitted that in total 18 bulk liter illicit foreign liquor has been seized from the possession of the applicant. Hence, he is not entitled for grant of bail.
4. Heard learned counsel for both the parties and perused the case diary.
5. Considering the submissions made and the contents of the case diary, detention of the applicant till completion of investigation and trial would not

serve any purpose. Hence, for these reasons the application deserves to be allowed.

6. Consequently, the application (MCRC No.6653/2017) filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. by the applicant is hereby allowed. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned Court, for his appearance as and when directed.
