(1) The applicant has filed this second application for grant of anticipatory bail as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No. 316/2014 registered at police station Sirgitti, District Bilaspur for the offence punishable under Sections 420, 270, 276 of Indian Penal Code of the Indian Penal Code.
