1. The present order is restricted for modification of order dated 12-04-2017 in WPS No.1714 of 2017. It is made clear that if the applicants do not file separate MCC in two other writ petitions, the respondents would be at liberty to initiate contempt proceedings against the applicants for not deciding the appeal within the stipulated time.
