1. This Court had earlier passed order dated 4.5.2017 recording the submission made before the Court that the Tribunal has become functional, however, the review petition was filed on the submission that the statement was without proper instructions and information and in fact the Tribunal was not functioning.

Now today, learned counsel for the parties placed before the Court, an order dated 13.7.2017 passed by the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, Delhi (In-Charge Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, Allahabad) which records that the petitioner's case would be coming up for hearing before DRAT on 9.8.2017 at Allahabad.
