(2) This is third bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.223/2014 registered at Police Station Kondagaon, District Kondagaon, for the offence punishable under Sections 420, 409, 467, 468, 471 r/w 34 of IPC.
