ORDER :

1. Mr. Deshmukh, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits on instructions that the petitioners desire to withdraw this petition. Mr. Patil, learned Counsel for Respondent No.5 submits that the petitioner – management is no longer conducting the said school as it has already been transferred during pendency of this petition. Mr. Deshmukh, learned Counsel submits that in future if there is any fresh cause of action, the petitioners may resort to fresh proceedings.
