ORAL ORDER :

On the last occasion, on 4th September, 2017, when the matter was called out, none appeared for the petitioner. Today also, none appears for the petitioner when the petition is called out.

2. Even otherwise, looking at the subject matter of the petition, the petitioner purports to challenge the communication dated 15th February, 2005, whereby the petitioner had been communicated that there is no change in the marks. Said communication pertains to
