Per Court:

1 The Petitioners are aggrieved by the interlocutory order dated 29.11.2001 by which the Industrial Court has rejected the application for interim relief in Complaint (ULP) No.140/2001.

2 By order dated 28.12.2001, this Court directed the parties to maintain status-quo. By order dated 08.01.2002, this Court admitted the petition and granted interim relief in terms of prayer clause (E), which reads as under:-

"(E) *The order passed by the learned member of the Industrial Court at Jalna dated 29.11.2001 below Exh.U-2 i.e. interim relief application may please be*

stayed during the pendency of the above writ petition and till its disposal by way of an order of interim relief."

3 The learned counsel for the Petitioners/ Employees submits that subsequently Complaint (ULP) No.140/2001 has been dismissed by the Industrial Court and the Writ Petition challenging the said judgment is pending in this Court. This Writ Petition, therefore, does not survive.

4 Considering the above, this Writ Petition is disposed of as being infructuous. Rule is discharged. Pending Civil Application does not survive and is disposed of.
