2. Mr. Sapkal, learned counsel submits that

the petitioners have filed an application seeking statutory benefit under Section 34 of the Land Acquisition Act (for short, 'the Act'). The Reference is filed by the petitioners. Reference is decided. In the said Reference also the Reference Court has not passed any order with regard to the statutory benefit under Section 34 of the Act. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners have filed application with respondent no.2 seeking the said benefit on 25.3.2013 and same is received by respondent no.2.
