Per Court:

1 The learned counsel for the Applicants submits that the appeal preferred by the Respondent/ Insurer came to be dismissed by this Court by order dated 01.04.2016. The Applicants pray to withdraw the amount deposited before this Court by the Respondent/ Insurer.

2 The learned counsel for the Respondent/ Insurer has no objection, if the Applicants are permitted to withdraw the said amount.

3 In view of the above, the Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (B).

4 However, the learned counsel for the Applicants submits that the Applicant No.4 is bedridden and she is not in a position to come to this Court. The Applicant No.5, who is her husband, may be permitted to

withdraw the amount falling to the share of the Applicant No.4.

5 In view of the above submissions, the Applicant No.5 is hereby permitted to withdraw the amount falling to the share of the Applicant No.4. The office to issue separate cross-cheques one for the Applicant Nos.1 to 3 and another for the Applicant Nos.4 and 5.

6 The Civil Application is, accordingly, disposed of.
