1. Mrs.Deshpande, learned counsel for
Respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits that the
petitioner has an alternate efficacious remedy of
filing an appeal under Rule 13 of the Maharashtra

Zilla Parishads District Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1964.

2. In view of that though Mr.Choudhari, learned counsel sought to canvass submissions on merits, we are not inclined to consider the same.
