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PER COURT :-

1. Learned counsel for respondent-insurer submits that, there are in all three claimants and out of them, two claimants are permitted to withdraw the compensation amount to the extent of 20% each, and as such, the applicant-third claimant may also be permitted to withdraw 20% of the amount deposited before this Court.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant has not disputed this position.
3. In view of the above, the applicant herein is permitted to withdraw 20% of the amount alongwith accrued interest thereon on furnishing an undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
