ORDER :

1. Learned counsel Mr. Bedre on behalf of the applicant states that Advocate MR. S. S. Chapalgaonkar has already put in appearance on behalf of respondents no. 1 to 4 and additionally, respondents have been served by private notice.
2. While the matter is called out, there is no appearance on behalf of respondents which, to a large extent, shows that there is no particular objection to granting of prayers made in civil application.

3. Thus, civil application stands granted in terms of prayer clauses (B) and (C).
