ORAL ORDER :

1. In the judgment dated 6th September 2017, inadvertently appearance of Mr. V.D. Sapkal, learned counsel is shown for all appellants in Criminal Appeal No.192/1999. Appearance of Mr. V.D. Sapkal, learned counsel be shown for appellants No.3 and 5 in Criminal Appeal No.192/1999. Similarly, in cause title of Criminal Appeal No.192/1999, the line "and all are in jail at present" be deleted.
