PER COURT:-

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, submits that the petitioners are intending to file revision/s before the Hon'ble Minister against the orders passed by the Commissioner, which are impugned in these petitions and thus seeks leave to withdraw these writ petitions.
