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PER COURT :-

1. Heard.
2. Read the contents of the compromise pursis. The parties are present in person and they are duly identified by their respective counsel. They have admitted the contents of the compromise pursis and their signatures/Thumb impressions on the compromise pursis. Compromise purshis is marked 'X' for identification. Thus, the contents of the compromise stand verified.

3. First Appeal is thus disposed of in terms of the compromise pursis. Parties to bear their own costs.

4. In terms of the compromise petition, award be drawn up accordingly.

5. The claimants are permitted to withdraw the amount as per the contents of the compromise and the amount in excess, if any, deposited before the Commissioner, the same shall be refunded to the appellants.

6. In view of disposal of the first appeal itself, nothing survives for consideration in pending civil application. Civil application accordingly disposed of.
