PER COURT :-

1 The facts giving rise to the instant petition are exactly similar to the facts of the disposed matter being writ Petition No.8006/2014 presented by V.D. Bardar versus State of Maharashtra & others.

2 For the reasons recorded while disposing of the aforesaid writ petition, this petition also deserves to be disposed of with a direction to respondent to deposit enhanced amount of compensation in accordance with the decision of the Reference Court, in the execution proceeding, as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of four months from today and it is accordingly directed.

3 On deposit of the amount, the same shall be disbursed to the decree holders.

4 The writ petition is disposed of.
