ORDER :

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant.
2. In spite of service, no appearance is caused on behalf of the respondent. In the circumstances, averments in the application go uncontested and uncontroverted. Absence on behalf of the respondent, to a large extent, reflects upon intention of the respondent, not to resist the transfer of proceedings, sought under the application.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant refers to various difficulties being faced by the applicant in attending to the proceedings of which transfer is sought, to a competent court at Jalna.

4. There is no resistance to the claims made by learned counsel for the applicant.

5. In the circumstances, Hindu Marriage Petition bearing no. 213 of 2015 pending before civil judge, senior division, Ahmednagar, Tq. and Dist. Ahmednagar, be transferred to a competent court at Jalna, as well as Misc. Civil Application no. 158 of 2015 pending before district court at Ahmednagar, be transferred to a competent court at Jalna.

6. Miscellaneous civil application accordingly stands disposed of.
