Grievance of the petitioner is that though he had made a representation to respondent no.03 - Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies on 16.02.2016, seeking permission to file criminal and civil proceedings against respondent no.04 - Liquidator under Section 107 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act, 1960, same has not yet been decided.

03. Therefore, without issuing notices to respondents, the petition can be conveniently disposed of by directing respondent no.03 - Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies to decide representation of the petitioner made on 16.02.2016, seeking permission to file criminal and civil proceedings against respondent no.04 - Liquidator under Section 107 of the Maharashtra Co-operative

Societies Act, 1960, on its own merits and in accordance with law, within four weeks. We direct accordingly.

04. With the above directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
