3. The appellant and the respondent present before the Court submits that they have voluntarily entered into the settlement and the respondent has paid the amount on account of cheque dishonored. The complainant has received the amount in full and final settlement of his claim. The complainant submits that in view of the settlement arrived he is not interested to proceed with the appeal against the judgment and order of acquittal of accused passed by the trial Court and urged to dispose of the appeal accordingly.
