ORDER :

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties. For the reasons contained in the Civil Application, despite stiff resistance on behalf of the appearing respondents, I deem it appropriate to grant the same. 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2017. As far as for those legal heirs of deceased respondent no.1-A who have given power to Mr. Mukhedkar, notice stands waived by the learned appearing counsel.
