ORDER:

1. Heard both the sides.
2. Learned counsel appearing for both the sides submit that in the connected matters this Court has allowed the claimants to withdraw 80 % amount of compensation (in Civil Application No. 5757/2016).
3. In view of the above, the learned counsel appearing for the Acquiring Body has no objection to pay 80 % amount.
4. Civil Application is allowed.
5. Applicant is permitted to withdraw 80 % amount of compensation along with accrued interest, on furnishing undertaking that in case adverse orders are

passed in the appeal the applicant will redeposit the amount in this court.

6. Remaining 20 % amount shall be invested in the fixed deposit receipt in the Nationalized Bank initially for a period of 13 months and thereafter shall be renewed from time to time as per the order of this Court.

7. Civil Application is disposed of.
