2. The learned AGP tenders across the Bar a copy of the judgment rendered by the Division Bench of this Court in the case of **Punbajrao s/o.**

Shrihari Wadje Patil Vs. The State of Maharashtra and ors. (Writ Petition No.154 of 2017 and other connected matters) dated 16.01.2017. He submits that the point involved in the present Writ Petition is squarely covered by the said judgment.

3. Since the point involved in the present Writ Petition is no more *res-integra* and is squarely covered by the judgment of the Division Bench in the case of **Punbajrao s/o. Shrihari Wadje Patil** (supra), we are not inclined to interfere in exercise of Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
