3. The applications, it appears that, are filed with the acquiring body and the respondent No. 1/Collector for payment of rental compensation. The petitioners may file applications with the respondent No. 2 seeking rental compensation. On receipt of said applications, the respondent No. 2 shall take decision upon the same on its own merits, in accordance with law after hearing all parties concerned, expeditiously and preferably within a period of six (06) months from the date of receipt of applications. The writ petitions accordingly are disposed of. No costs.
