Order :-

Heard learned counsel for the parties. There is delay of 31 days in filing the appeal. It has been submitted that other respondents have preferred appeal against impugned judgment and award passed by the learned Tribunal. This Court also passed order of simultaneous hearing of all appeals on merits. In such circumstances, applicant prayed for condonation of delay.

2. Learned counsel for respondents fairly conceded to condone the delay in the interest of justice for simultaneous hearing of the appeals altogether.
