ORAL ORDER

The application for transfer of proceedings is opposed on the ground that the applicant's real brother is residing at Pune and as such, she can conveniently attend the proceedings.

2. In my opinion, the application needs to be allowed in terms of prayer clause (B), for the reason that distance between Parbhani and Pune is almost 500 Kms. and there is no proper connectivity so as to feel it convenient to travel without an attendant to Pune.
