The Hon'ble the Chief Justice, on request from the litigants and the members of the bar, had taken a decision and which was ratified by the Full Court subsequently that old matters, particularly writ petitions on the original and appellate sides, which have been admitted more than five to ten years back and pending for a decade or more ought to be given priority in hearing and finally disposing them.
