In view of the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in **Rekapally Laxminarayanrao Naidu v. 2 Since the present matter pertains to selection of a
Assistant Professor in a Government College, the matter would lie
before the learned Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal.

3 The Petition is, therefore, rejected relegating the
Petitioner to an alternative remedy available in law.

4 Needless to state that the Petitioner would be entitled to
benefit of Section 14 of the Limitation Act, 1963 for a period during
which present petition was pending before this Court.
