1. Pursuant to the order dated 2nd February 2017 granting pre-arrest bail, the applicants-accused have attended the police station.

2. The learned counsel for the applicants-accused pointed out that the photographs of the prosecutrix and the applicant-accused Amit Jadhav showing that they were interested in each other. He further

submits that hereinafter the applicant-accused Amit Jadhav shall not contact the prosecutrix and shall keep away himself. He further submits that the applicants-accused do not have any criminal record.

3. The learned prosecutor while opposing this application informs the Court that the police have recorded the statements of the witnesses and the police have also read whatsapp and face-book chat, and it appears that they were very friendly with each other.

4. I have already perused the papers. It appears that this offence of kidnapping has taken place out of love affair. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the applicants-accused, I confirm the order of pre-arrest bail, which was earlier granted by the order dated 2nd February 2017 with the same terms and conditions, except that the applicants-accused shall attend the concerned police station as and when called, till the filing of the charge-sheet.

5. Anticipatory Bail Applications are disposed of accordingly.
