Heard learned Counsel for the parties. This Civil Application is for condonation of delay in filing the Appeal from Order.

2. It is not in dispute that the Applicants/Appellants were prosecuting their Appeal before the District Court and it is on only 04-03-2016 the District Court held that it has no pecuniary jurisdiction to entertain the Appeal.
