1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties and the following order is passed by consent :

(i) The parties shall proceed with the divorce proceedings before the Family Court, Pune.

(ii) The learned Judge of the Family Court shall record the cross-examination of the witnesses of the Petitioner and thereafter allow the Petitioner herein to lead her evidence as well as the evidence of her witnesses. Upon the examination and cross-examination being completed, the learned Judge shall pass his order within a period of three weeks. The entire exercise of leading evidence as well as passing of the order shall be completed by the learned Judge on or before 10th July, 2017.
