1. Civil Application No. 1441 of 2003 seeks condonation of delay in filing the First Appeal. The Appeal itself is beyond time by 138 days. The amount awarded is Rs. 13,110/-. This is too insignificant an amount to justify any expenditure of time.

2. Civil Application No. 1441 of 2003 is dismissed.

3. Consequently, First Appeal is dismissed. No costs.
4. There is a delay of 2 years and 164 days in filing Civil Application (St) No. 5352 of 2012. Although, the Appeal is dismissed, however, heirs and legal representatives of the deceased sole Respondent are to be brought on record as Respondents Nos. 1 to 3 after condoning the delay of 2 years and 164 days. That delay is condoned. Amendment to be carried out within three weeks from today. Civil Application (St) No. 5352 of 2012 is disposed of in these terms.
5. All other Civil Applications are disposed of as infructuous.
