1. None for the applicant/appellant. The appeal is against the order dated 27th November 2009 dismissing the plaintiff's Suit. The suit was for possession and mandatory injunction to direct defendant No. 2 to disconnect the electricity meter installed in the name of defendant No. 1 and transfer it in the name of the plaintiff.

2. None appears for the appellants. Only the 2nd respondent is served.

3. The civil application seeking condonation of delay is dismissed for want of prosecution. Consequently, the first appeal is also dismissed. The civil application seeking stay does not survive and is disposed of as infructuous.
