Mr. Shinde, learned Government Pleader has produced the communication dated 19th April, 2017 from the Scheduled Tribe Certificate Security Committee, Nashik stating therein that the compliance of the order passed by this Court on 29th April, 2016 in Writ Petition No. 4071 of 2016 will be made within four weeks. He also submits that since there was some misunderstanding about the implementation of the order, the caste validity certificate could

not be issued by the Committee within time fixed in the Writ Petition.
