1. Mr.Sumit Kate the learned counsel for the appellant states that all respondent except respondent no.2 are served. He points out that respondent no.2 is only a formal party and infact, in the trial Court, his name was ordered to be deleted. In view of the aforesaid he seeks to delete respondent no.2 from the cause title. Leave is granted. Necessary amendment to be carried out forthwith.
