1. Mr Joshi states that both the Civil Applications and the First Appeal have been dismissed against Respondent No. 2 for non-service because the Appellant could not provide the correct address.
2. The Appeal and the two Civil Applications are been restored.
3. Mr Joshi states that if the correct address of the 2nd Respondent is not available, an application will be filed for substituted service. That statement is accepted.

4. There is a delay of 61 days in filing the Civil Application. The delay is condoned. Civil Application No. 2081 of 2017 is made absolute.
