2 It is required to be noted that the Respondent was paying an amount of Rs. 5,000/- to the Applicant as maintenance pending the Marriage Petition. He has continued to pay the same and has paid @ rate of Rs. 5,000/- till November 2016.

3 Considering the fact that the Applicant is a housewife and would require some amount for her maintenance, We are of the considered view that an amount of Rs. 10,000/- per month would suffice for her maintenance and sustenance. However, the said amount would be payable from June 2017. In so far the amount which was being paid @ rate of Rs. 5,000/- per month is concerned, the Respondent may pay the maintenance at the said rate up to May 2017. The arrears, if, they can be called so can be cleared within 8 weeks from date. The amount for June 2017 also to be paid within 2 weeks from date.

4 In the light of the above, the relief sought by the Applicant/Wife for maintenance @ rate of Rs. 50,000/- per month cannot be acceded to. The Civil Application is partly allowed to the aforesaid extent and disposed of.

5 Needless to state that the Respondent/Husband would continue to pay the maintenance of the flat wherein the Applicant is residing as well as the property taxes for the same.
