1. By this petition the petitioner seeks to challenge order dated 10th February, 2017 whereby revision application made by the applicant therein - original complainant was allowed in part and order dated 20th August, 2014 was set aside. Paragraph 3 of the order reads as follows :-

“On filing the complaint Ld. Magistrate heard applicant and it revealed to him that investigation on earlier report lodged by applicant is pending.
