1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicants and the learned counsel for the Intervener.
2. The applicants are apprehending arrest in C. R. No. I-169 dated 13.04.2017 registered with Narpoli Police Station, Bhivandi, District Thane under Sections 379, 420, 465, 467, 471 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 103, 104, 107 of the Trade Marks Act.
