1. None for the Petitioners. There is a second call after the matter was kept back in the morning session. On 20th June 1996 there was an order that the matter was to be listed along with Writ Petition No. 2247 of 1996 as per the order passed in that Petition. There is subsequent note on 17th November 2016 that the Petition is still pending for admission though ordered to be heard with Writ Petition No.2247 of 1996.
