1 This is application for condonation of delay in filing an appeal challenging conviction of applicants/accused for offence punishable under Section 324 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2 None for the applicants. Heard the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent/State. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the application by contending that there is no sufficient cause to condone the delay.

3 Perused the application. The application is on affidavit. The delay sought to be condoned is only of four days. Applicants are challenging conviction. Averments in the application for condonation of delay are on affidavit. Those are not controverted.
