

cannot conclude that every person is thrown out without following the procedure. It cannot be an omnibus opinion. Each encroacher may have certain rights, if at all he has and if there is non-compliance of the procedure contemplated, it is in their personal right they have to approach the Court and challenge such non-compliance and not in the form of public interest where common directions could be given. If individual encroachers are aggrieved by the action of the special drive committee or action taking committee, they are at liberty to approach the Court in their individual capacity. With these directions, PIL is disposed of.
