Civil Application No. 3099 of 2016:

1. The delay in filing the First Appeal is sufficiently explained. Delay condoned. The Civil Application is disposed of in these terms with no order as to costs.

2. **Admit.** By consent taken up for hearing and final disposal forthwith on the basis of the record that is in the compilation accompanying the First Appeal.

3. This appeal is by the husband of the Claimant (1st Respondent in Appeal) in FA St No 4530 of 2016. He, too, was injured in the same accident. He filed a separate claim. The grounds of appeal are identical.
