2 The Applicants have been granted bail by this Court by order dated 15.12.2011. While granting bail, condition was imposed that the Applicants shall report to the concerned police station, i.e., MIDC Police Station, Solapur once in two months.

5 In view of the fact that the Applicants have diligently attended the concerned police station for about 6 ½ years and the fact that there is no complaint of any nature against the Applicants nor any misuse of liberty has occurred at the hands of the Applicants, the condition of reporting to the concerned police station is relaxed.
