1. The disputes are settled. Consent terms are tendered. These are signed by the appellant (original defendant) and by the constituted attorney of the respondent (original plaintiff). The consent terms are taken on record and marked "X" for identification with today's date.

2. The consent terms are in order. They are not contrary to law. I am satisfied that they have been drawn by the parties of their own

volition in reflection of their true intentions. The undertakings in the consent terms are accepted as undertakings to the Court.

3. The first draft of Rs 2 lakhs in accordance with clause (3) of the consent terms is ready. The amount is agreed to be deposited in court. That deposit will be made by the end of the day tomorrow.

4. The first appeal is disposed of in accordance with the consent terms. There will be no order as to costs.

5. The civil applications do not survive and are disposed of as infructuous.
